



MARCIELLO AHEAD OF KVYAT IN FREE PRACTICE

03.05.2013. Raffaele Marciello (Prema Powerteam, 1:33.941 minutes) started into the third racing weekend of the 2013 FIA Formula 3 European Championship. At the 4.574 kilometres long Hockenheimring Baden-Württemberg, guest driver Daniil Kvyat (Carlin, 1:34.019 minutes) ended up second from rookie Jordan King (Carlin, 1:34.041 minutes) and Sven Müller (ma-con, 1:34.206 minutes).

Raffaele Marciello dominated proceedings from the very beginning, the Italian already moved up into first place in the first few minutes. He ended up as the fastest driver in the first part of the two-heat session, just like in the second part. In the first half, Marciello was toppled briefly by Felix Rosenqvist (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport, 1:34.298 minutes), but he countered right away and claimed back the lead with two outright fastest sector times.

Behind Marciello, Daniil Kvyat surprised by setting the second fastest time in free practice. The Russian, who is a guest driver at Hockenheim, was only 0.078 seconds faster than Marciello and ended up second in the 29 drivers' strong field. Kvyat's teammate Jordan King was classified third and thus ensured that two Carlin drivers were in the top three.

Sven Müller, who has a home event at Hockenheim, also showed a strong performance. The German, who is only living 100 kilometres away from the race track, was classified fourth in the first session of the weekend, followed by Lucas Auer (Prema Powerteam, 1:34.212 minutes), Felix Rosenqvist, Félix Serrallés (Fortec Motorsports, 1:34.322 minutes), Josh Hill (Fortec Motorsports, 1:34.373 minutes), Harry Tincknell (Carlin, 1:34.494 minutes) and Alex Lynn (Prema Powerteam, 1:34,543 minutes). In total, 18 drivers were classified within one second.
