12.07.2013. Daniil Kvyat (Carlin, 0:49.158 minutes) and Harry Tincknell (Carlin, 0:49.159 minutes) were the fastest drivers in free practice of the FIA Formula 3 European Championship. At the 2.3 kilometres long Norisring, the two young drivers were separated by just one thousandth of a second. Raffaele Marciello (Prema Powerteam, 0:49.218 minutes) and Tom Blomqvist (Eurointernational, 0:49.246 minutes) followed in second and third place. In total, the lap times of 26 drivers were within one second.

In bright sunshine and warm temperatures of just below 30 °C, the drivers of the FIA Formula 3 European Championship started into the Norisring weekend. Red Bull junior driver Daniil Kvyat set the fastest time in the two-part session, having moved up to the top of the time sheets just before the end. Harry Tincknell, too, climbed up into second place with just over two minutes remaining and toppled Raffaele Marciello, who had been in the lead for a long time, to third place. As the track got faster, Tom Blomqvist and Sven Müller (ma-con, 0:49.253 minutes) also set their best lap times towards the end of the session and claimed fourth and fifth place respectively.

In sixth place, Jordan King (Carlin, 0:49.254 minutes) was the best-placed rookie and thus ended up ahead of his compatriot Alexander Sims (ThreeBond with T-Sport, 0:49.269 minutes). At the Norisring, guest driver Sims is making his comeback in Formula 3. Alex Lynn (Prema Powerteam, 0:49.304 minutes), Felix Rosenqvist (Mücke Motorsport, 0:49.324 minutes) and Félix Serrallés (Fortec Motorsports, 0:49.379 minutes) rounded out the top ten. New Zealand's Nick Cassidy (Eurointernational, 0:49.838 minutes), a novice in the FIA Formula 3 European Championship field, ended up 22nd in his maiden free practice.
