10.10.2014. In the free practice session of the 10th FIA Formula 3 European Championship race meeting, Italian Antonio Fuoco (Prema Powerteam, 1:36.991 minutes) set the fastest lap time. With this time, the Ferrari Driver Academy member was the only driver who broke the 1:37-minute barrier, at Imola's 4.909-kilometre Autodromo Enzo e Dino Ferrari. Esteban Ocon (Prema Powerteam, 1:37.120 minutes) secured second position, right behind his team-mate, with Max Verstappen (Van Amersfoort Racing, 1:37.135 minutes) and Felix Rosenqvist (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport, 1:37.151 minutes) coming third and fourth respectively.

Antonio Fuoco started into his home event in fine style - by setting the fastest lap time in the free practice session. Thanks to the second place on the time sheets secured by FIA Formula 3 European Championship leader Esteban Ocon, it was a one-two for the Italian Prema Powerteam. Dutchman Max Verstappen - who contested his first Formula 1 practice session, last weekend - came third behind the Prema pairing and so, all the three top positions on the time sheets were secured by rookies. Behind them, Felix Rosenqvist in fourth position was the quickest of the experienced drivers. Antonio Giovinazzi (Jagonya Ayam with Carlin, 1:37.200 minutes), Nicolas Latifi (Prema Powerteam, 1:37.243), Tom Blomqvist (Jagonya Ayam with Carlin, 1:37.303) and Jordan King (Carlin, 1:37,311) secured the positions five to eight, with Jake Dennis (Carlin, 1:37.530 minutes) and Sean Gelael (Jagonya Ayam with Carlin, 1:37.674) completing the top 10.

Returnee Nick Cassidy (ThreeBond with T-Sport, 1:37.681 minutes) finished 11th, in his first FIA Formula 3 European Championship practice session of the 2014 season and William Buller (Signature, 1:3.767) came 12th in the session that meant the FIA Formula 3European Championship comeback for both his team and himself.
