26.06.2015. Charles Leclerc (Van Amersfoort Racing, 0:48.704 minutes) will be competing in his first-ever races at the only 2.300 kilometres long Norisring this weekend, but the Monegasque had little trouble in getting used to the street circuit in Nuremberg. In free practice of the FIA Formula 3 European Championship, he posted the fastest time and thus was 0.053 seconds faster than Alexander Albon (Signature, 0:48.757 minutes). Antonio Giovinazzi (Jagonya Ayam with Carlin, 0:48.796 minutes) ended up third from Felix Rosenqvist (Prema Powerteam, 0:48.831 minutes), Dorian Boccolacci (Signature, 0:48.916 minutes) and Mikkel Jensen (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport, 0:49.073 minutes).

Due to the high number of participants with 32 drivers, the field was divided into two groups for free practice. Charles Leclerc, the current FIA Formula 3 European Championship points' leader, already moved up to the top of his group at an early stage and remained in front for most of the time to end up fastest in the session. Albon, Giovinazzi and Rosenqvist also managed to post lap times under 49 seconds and ended up in second to fourth place respectively.

Dorian Boccolacci finished fastest in the group that had to go out on track first and thus had to cope with slightly more adverse conditions. Mikkel Jensen, Lance Stroll (Prema Powerteam, 0:49.095 minutes), George Russell (Carlin, 0:49.109 minutes), Brandon Maïsano (Prema Powerteam, 0:49.113 minutes) and Ryan Tveter (Jagonya Ayam with Carlin, 0:49.115 minutes) rounded out the top ten, that included seven rookies and no less than eight drivers who completed their first laps of the Norisring. In total, the lap times of 29 drivers were within one second.
